It is important to apply the wax at an interval of months in order to keep the exterior shiny and well maintained.

Choosing the right kind of wax for your car is very important to assure the shine for your car. You should choose a wax that does not contain abrasives. A wax containing abrasives can cause scratches to the surface and can haze the paint.

Carnauba Wax is believed to be of good quality by many people. Carnauba Wax is more expensive but is better than the others because of its ability to stick and being easier to buff. However, hard work is still required during the application no matter how good the quality of the Car Wax is. Reading the instructions on the product is important before applying the car wax. Instead of applying the Car wax on the entire surface at once, it should be first tested on a patch.

When applying the Car Wax, it should be assured that the car is not parked in direct sunlight. This is because the car wax works better on a surface that is relatively cool. While applying Car Wax, one sections should be completed before proceeding to the other one.

Before applying the Car Wax, the car should be thoroughly washed and dried. A Car Wax is generally considered good if it is relatively difficult to apply. This is due to the reason that the car waxes which are difficult to apply are effective for a shorter period of time.

The Car Wax should be applied using a wax sponge. Use circular motions during the application of the Wax and you should take care that the wax doesn't get into seams and jambs. If this happens, a toothbrush can be used for removing it. The Car Wax can be wiped off with the help of a towel.
